ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Uncommon NYC is proud to serve all students – including those with special needs and English Language Learners. Our special education team ensures that students with special needs have the support, services, and accommodations they need to succeed.

While Uncommon Schools offers Kindergarten through 12th grade, we only accept applications for children entering Pre-K through 10th grade. We do not currently accept applications for 11th & 12th grade at any of our high schools.

A charter school shall not discriminate against or limit the admission of any student on any unlawful basis, including on the basis of ethnicity, national origin, gender, disability, intellectual ability, measures of achievement or aptitude, athletic ability, race, creed, gender, or religion. A school may not require any action by a student or family (such as an admissions test, interview, essay, attendance at an information session, etc.) in order for an applicant to either receive or submit an application for admission to that school.
