This policy provides the list of records in the possession of the School. Some of these documents are considered public documents and may be made available to the public under the Freedom of Information Law (FOIL). The FOIL policy, including the process by which records may be requested, is contained in the student handbook, available on the school's website.

Pursuant to FOIL, a record is defined as any information kept, held, filed, produced or reproduced by, with or for an agency or the state legislature, in any physical form whatsoever including, but not limited to, reports, statements, examinations, memoranda, opinions, folders, files, books, manuals, pamphlets, forms, papers, designs, drawings, maps, photos, letters, microfilms, computer tapes or discs, rules, regulations or codes.

- \circ A record of the final vote of each trustee in every proceeding in which the trustees vote*
- o A record setting forth the name, public office address, title and salary of every officer or employee of the education corporation.
- *May contain personal, confidential or other information that should not be released pursuant FOIL, the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, and/or the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (exceptions FOIL).

The Records Access Officer shall insure that School personnel maintain:

- i. Maintain an up-to-date subject matter list;
- ii. Assist persons seeking records to identify the records sought;
- iii. Contact persons seeking records when a request is voluminous or when locating the records involves substantial effort, so that personnel may ascertain the nature of records of primary interest and attempt to reasonably reduce the volume of records requested;
- iv. Upon locating the records, take one of the following actions:
 - a. Make records available for inspection; or,
 - b. Deny access to the records in whole or in part and explain in writing.
- v. Upon request for copies of records:
- a. Make a copy available upon payment or offer to pay established fees, if any, in accordance with Section 8; or,
 - b. Permit the requester to copy those records.
- vi. Upon request, certify that a record is a true copy; and
- vii. Upon failure to locate records, certify that;
 - a. (School's name) is not the custodian for such records, or
- b. The records of which (School's name) is a custodian cannot be found after diligent search.
